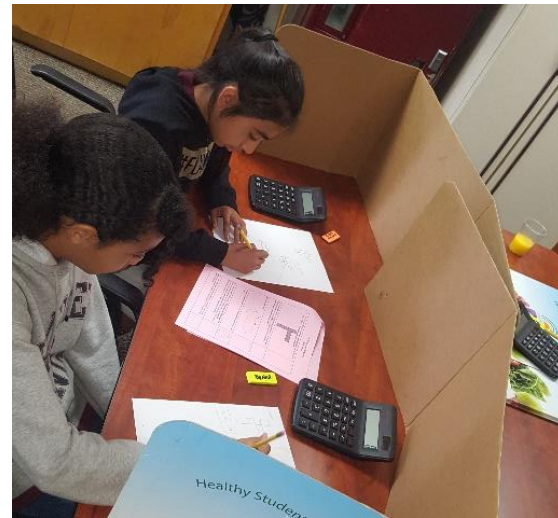


Coaches' Collective
